### 1 . Visit to Bangkok (June 26, 2024)

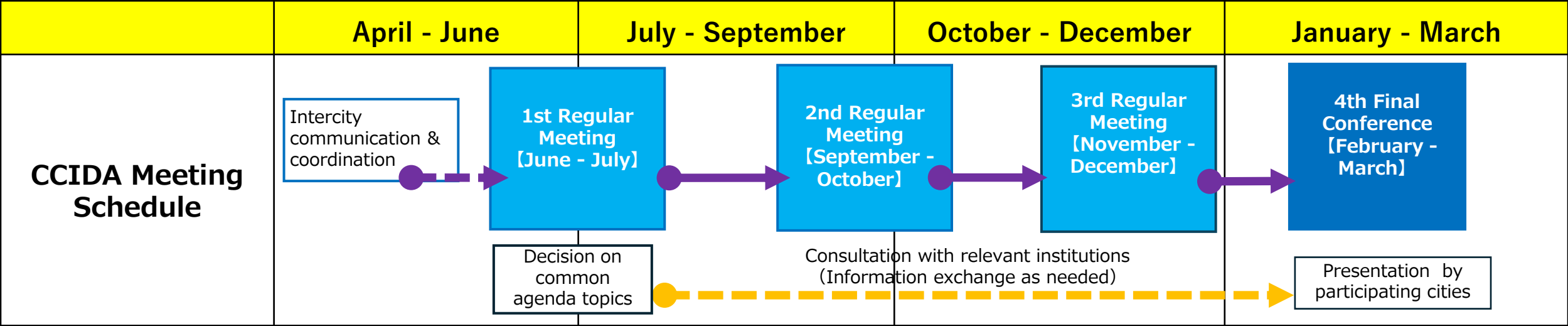

FY2025 CCIDA Meeting Schedule and Plan



## 1 Meeting System

- Four meetings will be held in FY2025 to promote active communication between cities.
- The common intercity discussion for FY2025 will focus on a single agenda item, with all participating cities collaborating on its review and findings.
- Since the CCIDA meetings resumed after several years in FY2024, Tokyo Metropolitan Government (TMG) played a central role in providing infectious disease-related information. However, in FY2025, information-sharing from participating cities is strongly encouraged.

## 2 Proactive Utilization of k-net

- In FY2025, the goal is to fully utilize k-net as a tool for information sharing, establishing an efficient and collaborative intercity communication system.
