

In conjunction with the national testing promotion week (June 1 - 7), the Tokyo Metropolitan Government has designated **June 1 - 30** as the “**Tokyo Metropolitan HIV Testing and Counseling Month**” to expand testing and raise awareness

Expansion of anonymous and free testing for HIV and syphilis

- **Expand testing system** through the Shinjuku East Exit Testing and Consultation Office

Starting April, the **opening hours have been extended** and the **testing slots have been increased**. The **Ladies’ Day** has also become **permanent** (once a week).

For the whole month of June, **chlamydia and gonorrhea testing** will also be provided, on top of HIV and syphilis testing.

- **Increase testing days** at public health centers in Tokyo

Add more days for HIV and syphilis testing at **14 public health centers**
