

TMG AIDS Prevention Month

The period **from November 16 to December 15**, centered on “World AIDS Day” on December 1, is designated as the “**TMG AIDS Prevention Month**” and expands HIV testing and implements awareness activities



“Do you know about HIV?”

By “**correctly understanding**” the latest information on HIV/AIDS, **promote early detection and early treatment, and eliminate discrimination and prejudice**



Primary initiatives

◆ Expansion of inspection system

- **Event testing** conducted at 21 public health centers, etc.
- **Testing for chlamydia and gonorrhea added** at some locations



◆ Implementation of "AIDS Fest 2025" 11/29 @ Naka-Ikebukuro Park

- **Youth participation events** such as quizzes with popular influencers
- **Establishment of booths for reservation support for HIV testing and sexually transmitted disease consultation**



◆ Display of awareness flags

- City dressing on **Tocho-mae Chuo-dori and Shinjuku 2-chome Naka-dori**

◆ Holding of seminars for medical institutions and welfare facilities, etc. December 10

- Implemented on the theme of **long-term medical care support** in communities accompanying the **aging of HIV-positive people**



Number of HIV infected persons and AIDS patients reported in Tokyo


- The number of reports in Tokyo has **remained almost flat** since the COVID-19 pandemic
- Among the reported cases, **the proportion of those who have developed AIDS is increasing**, and **early detection is a challenge**


Number of reported cases of syphilis in Tokyo

- The number of reports in Tokyo in 2024 has **reached a record high for four consecutive years** since the survey began in 1999
- The number of reports in Tokyo in 2025 has been **trending slightly below the previous year**
