Variants in Tokyo



> Expert opinion from Tokyo iCDC's Prof. Miyasaka Masayuki*



- In Tokyo XBB is the main variant (82.4% of cases as of December 7)
- EG.5 represents the majority of all cases (64.7%)
- The XBB variant has a similar antigenicity (EG.5 and XBB.1.5 are also similar)
 - * (*Masayuki Miyasaka, Guest Professor, Immunology Frontier Research Center, Osaka University)
 - The XBB.1.5 vaccine should work well against all XBB subvariants.
 - The XBB.1.5 vaccine is strongly likely to be effective against EG.5, the main subvariant at the moment.
 - Booster vaccinations also work to some extent to prevent infection, which should further prevent hospitalizations and deaths.
